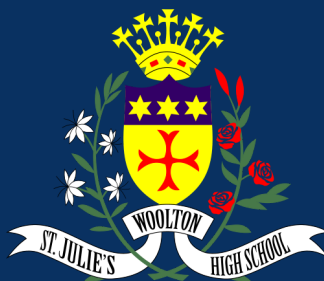
LABOUR MARKET INFORMATION FACT
