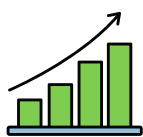
OPPORTUNITIES

The Government Economic Service are opening their Degree Application Programme in January 2022. You can read more and prepare for your application utilising their guides that are available to download here.

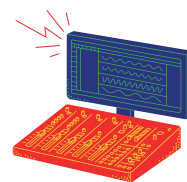

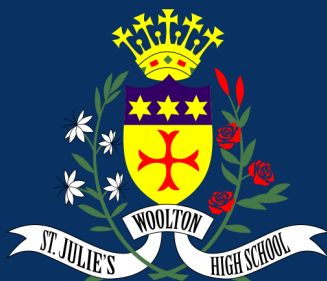
LABOUR MARKET INFORMATION FACT
