OPPORTUNITIES

T Levels are a new type of qualification in the UK. They are Level 3 (the same level as A Levels) and offer the opportunity to complete an extended work placement as part of your course. There is been rumors that they are not accepted by universities. This is false. Lots of universities accept T Levels (and their UCAS points) as part of their entry requirements, and encourage T Levels students to consider Higher Education options. 
